2009 LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM

Approved by the KASC Delegates at the Sept. 2008 Delegate Meeting

WE RESPECTFULLY ASK THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE GOVERNOR TO:

1. Continue to hold school councils accountable for improving student performance, as measured by the CATS assessment.
2. Increase funding to the level needed to achieve proficiency by 2014 and take the revenue steps needed to achieve that funding.
3. Maintain at least the current level of council responsibility in the principal selection process.
4. Revise the principal selection process to address the following issues:
 - Require principal selection training to be at least 3 hours and be conducted by a KDE-certified SBDM trainer.
 - Restrict the outgoing principal from participating in the selection of the new principal.
 - Clarify that the superintendent appoints the interim principal, after consultation with the council. The interim serves until the council selects a new principal.
 - Specify that a candidate is not a qualified applicant for a principal position in a school from which the applicant has been fired or demoted.
