| Have a current lease or execute one using this lease template. Must submit necessary paperwork. Must sign the HHERF settlement agreement, agreeing to: Forgive nonpayment late fees, penalties, interest, and court/legal fees. Not evict for rent due prior to April 2020. Not to initiate eviction until 45 days after assistance concludes. Give 30 days' notice for any future eviction. |
